## **Title fee for FIDE Lecturers**

Dear friends,

except the titles of FIDE Arbiter and International Arbiter, there is another title that an Arbiter may be awarded by FIDE. This is the title of FIDE Lecturer.

A FIDE Lecturer may conduct an official FIDE Arbiters' Seminar and give lectures for 16 hours and then conduct an examination test for the participants for at least 2 hours. According to the regulations he may receive the stipend of 1.500 euros for a 4-5 days Seminar.

FIDE has not determined any fee for this title so far.

At the moment there 67 FIDE Lecturers that have been included in the official FIDE list http://www.fide.com/FIDE/handbook/ListOfLecturersArbitersSeminars.pdf

Five more will be included after the approval of the 2017 FIDE Congress.

As in the Agenda of the 2017 Antalya FIDE Congress has been included the increasment of the fees for all titles, it should be acceptable a fee for the FIDE Lecturer title (i.e.  $300 \in$ ). The fee can be in effect from 1 January 2018.
